The parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and our unrepresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, which our more presentable parts do not require. You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to Him. But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you. Our Struggle with Sin David says it so well: See Psalm 40. Pray for victory over sin, Jesus has already accomplished it.

"Lord, turn to me and hear my cry! We the people of Redeemer know your ways but we struggle with sin, sin has become a habit we cannot easily shake away. May Your resurrection power lift us out of this miry pit. Troubles without number have surrounded us; our sins have overtaken us and we, like David, cannot see anymore. O my God, do not delay. Forgive us and cleanse us and prepare us for your purposes. Amen."

For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, in proportion to our faith; if service, in our serving; the one who teaches, in his teaching; the one who exhorts, in his exhortation; the one who contributes, in generosity; the one who leads, with zeal; the one who does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness. [Romans 12:1-8](#)

Giving 'O LORD, we have seen how you, through your Grace have prepared our hearts for yourself and no other. This affects all that we do and makes our giving to you a singleness of heart.
